

Global Training Workshop on International Human Rights and Environmental Law, Climate Change and the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples

OBJECTIVES:

1. to provide the participants with basic knowledge of International Human Rights and Environmental Law and the roles of States and international bodies and institutions in implementing these.
2. to enhance understanding of the participants on the history and contents of the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples and the state of implementation of this international instrument.
3. to familiarize the participants with the Human-rights Based Approach to Development (HRBA) and the Ecosystems Approach (EA)
4. to identify further steps on how to particularize, use and promote the HRBA and the EA as the frameworks for pursuing indigenous peoples' approaches and solutions to climate change and biodiversity conservation and sustainable use.
